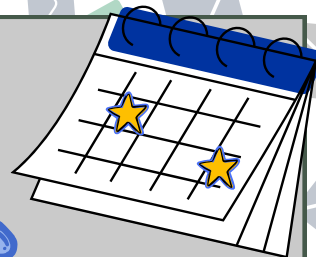

Agriculture Appreciation Lunch



Pictured above are the 4-Her's that attended the 2025 Agriculture Appreciation Lunch with the Country Ham that raised over \$13,000 for local 4-H programs.

On February 6th over 40 4-H members had the opportunity to attend the Logan County Agriculture Appreciation Luncheon. The Kentucky Commissioner of Agriculture, Jonathan Shell was the guest speaker, and he spoke about the importance of the next generation in agriculture. Commissioner Shell was a 4-H member himself, so he understands firsthand the value of organizations like 4-H and FFA. 4-H transforms young people into successful leaders, teaches valuable life skills, and provides growth in many areas like agriculture, communication, the workforce, health, and leadership. One of the 4-H programs in Logan County is Country Ham Project. This is where 4-Hers learn to cure a ham from start to finish and then give a speech on the process. This program allows kids to gain responsibility, improve communication skills, and learn about an agricultural process they can use in their future. During the Ag Lunch 4-H auctioned off a Country Ham from the 2024 project year. 4-H was able to raise over \$13,000 to support programs like 4-H camp, and to provide more opportunities for 4-Hers to learn and grow. We would like to say a huge thank you to H & R Agri-power and Independence Bank for their contributions that purchased the Country Ham. Additionally, we would like to thank the small businesses, farms, and Friends of 4-H for their contributions supporting Logan County 4-H!

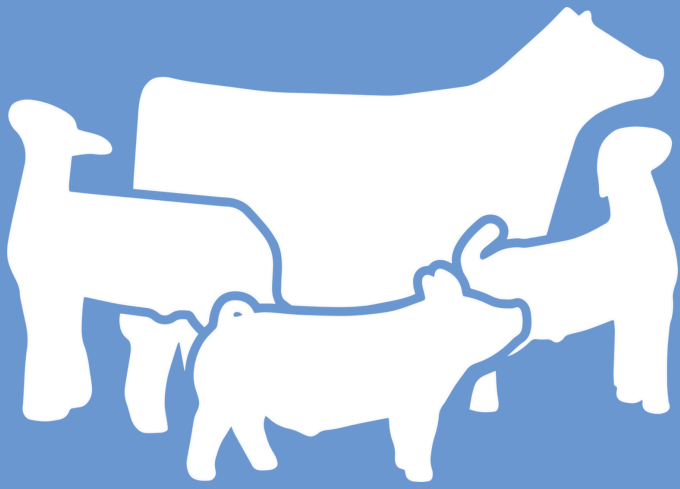

4-H Poster Contest

CONTEST RULES

- Poster should promote 4-H and/or opportunities through 4-H (catchy sayings or identify project areas).
- Poster must be created by a currently enrolled 4-H'er. (Contact Extension Office to enroll if needed.)
- Well-known cartoon figures that are copyrighted cannot be used.
- All posters must be designed on, or affixed to poster board of 14 x 22 inch dimensions. (This is 1/2 of a standard poster board size.)
- Any medium including watercolor, ink, crayon, acrylic, charcoal, oils, collages, etc, may be used to produced posters as long as they are NOT three dimensional.
- 4-H must be the topic of the poster.
- Youth MUST include the following information on the BACK of the poster: Name; Age (as of 01/01/2023); Address; Club; County; and a brief artwork interpretive statement.

Green Eggs for St. Patrick's Day

Makes 6 1/2 cup servings
90 calories per serving

Ingredients:

6 eggs
1 tablespoon milk
2 tablespoons roughly chopped onion
1 cup fresh kale or spinach leaves, washed, with big stems removed
Salt and pepper to taste
1 tablespoon canola oil

Directions:

Combine eggs, milk, onion, kale or spinach, salt and pepper in a blender and blend until the greens are pureed into little bits.
Heat canola oil in a frying pan over medium-low heat.
Pour the egg mixture into the warm pan. Let it sit for a couple minutes before you begin to stir and scramble with a spatula. Cook until eggs are done all the way through.
Serve warm.
