



## Makes 12 serving, ⅓ cup each 15 Calories/Serving

#### **Ingredients:**

- 2 cups melon, honeydew, cantaloupe or watermelon, seeded and diced
- 1 cup cucumber, peeled, seeded and diced
- 1/4 cup onion, diced
- 2 tablespoons fresh cilantro, parsley or mint, minced
- 1 jalapeno, seeded and minced
- 1/4 cup lime or lemon juice
- 1 tablespoon sugar

#### Directions:

- 1. In a medium-sized bowl, stir together all ingredients.
- 2. Taste and season with more lemon or lime juice, and sugar if needed.
- 3. Cover and chill for at least 30 minutes.
- 4. Serve with grilled or broiled fish or chicken or with whole-grain tortilla chips.

#### Tips:

- 1. Use one type of melon or a combination to make this salsa.
- 2. When handling hot peppers, the oils can cause burning and skin irritation. Wear clean kitchen gloves or wash hands thoroughly after preparing. KEEP HANDS AWAY FROM EYES.
- 3. Pair this salsa with grilled fish, quinoa, steamed cauliflower and milk.
